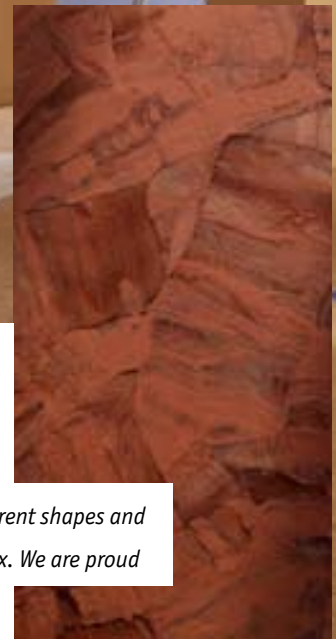
Megalit Contrasts in balance

Evolution by Tarkett

The secret behind Megalit's new and extraordinary pattern image involves mainly sizes and shapes. Until today, vinyl flooring has been made with granules that are all very similar. But for Megalit, we use large flakes with different shapes and sizes. The pattern's striking depth and variation result from the high proportion of transparent material in the mix. We are proud to present this unique patent pending manufacturing process as a Tarkett innovation.



A future classic

For over 50 years, we have been developing new homogeneous vinyl floorings based on people's needs. Megalit is founded on totally new thinking in production technology. Instead of the usual granules, we are using large flakes composed of highquality raw materials and pigments. This innovative method produces a flooring with a pleasingly irregular pattern that gives it a natural character, and a completely original design expression that will set new standards for the future.

Aspects of harmony

Megalit has been created within the framework of Tarkett's overall design concept to meet a desire for a fresh, natural look in interior decoration. The creative process was influenced by the fascinating natural materials that can be found in our surroundings, which is why Megalit can feel so right the very first time you see it. Manufactured of high-quality raw materials in a well balanced composition, and reinforced with our 3rd generation PUR, Megalit has outstanding maintenance properties. No polish or wax is needed, only dry buffing, throughout the lifetime of the flooring. Our patent pending manufacturing process and unique technical advances give properties such as improved resistance to scratches, abrasion and stains, along with remarkable material strength and flexibility. Megalit is available in 24 versatile colours. The characteristic pattern is achieved by using vinyl flakes in different shapes and sizes, and a high proportion of transparent material in the mix. Megalit is suitable for use in most commercial areas.
