Monolit derives its name from the Greek word monólithus meaning "a large object formed from a single piece of material, e.g. a stone block". Although Monolit is not made of stone, the impression is of a material which is just as pure, beautiful and fresh.

Monolit is a flooring based on decades of knowledge of what is needed to meet all the professional requirements for wear-resistance, hygiene, ease of maintenance, design and economy, while at the same time paying maximum consideration to the environment by reducing the need for chemicals and water in cleaning work.

In order that it may carry the Tarkett Sommer name, the flooring must fulfil the tough requirements set for public areas, such as hospitals, schools, nursery schools, public establishments, offices, etc.

Tarkett Monolit.

The first vinyl flooring in the new generation.

Monolit is reinforced with PUR (polyurethane), exactly the same as all high quality low maintenance flooring from Tarkett Sommer.

There are two reasons for this.

The first is that years of public research have shown that flooring from Tarkett Sommer with PUR allows daily cleaning to be completed with dry/damp cleaning methods, which simplifies cleaning work considerably.

Secondly, the need for cleaning chemicals is reduced by as much as 80%, since no chemical additives are needed to meet the requirements for hygiene set by, for example, hospitals, schools, laboratories, etc.

At the same time the use of water is reduced by half, thus saving both costs and the environment, reducing the risk of injury as a result of slipping, and economizing on natural resources. Heel marks and stains are easy to remove and the floor looks generally cleaner.

The simple cleaning methods have another great ergonomic advantage in that the risk of wear and tear to the cleaners' arms and shoulders is reduced considerably.

Easy to care for, inexpensive to own.

Monolit belongs to the type of flooring which is economic to own. The reason is naturally the comparatively very low running costs, since the flooring does not need to (neither should it) be treated with polish or wax year after year. There-fore there are no residues of previous treatment layers to be removed.

Unfortunately, there are still those who choose flooring based on price alone, without taking into consideration the fact that the cost of caring for a floor over its lifetime, is on average, ten times its purchase price.

Those who are interested both in sparing the environment and reducing future maintenance costs choose wisely

- and have money left over for other, and more profitable, investments.

Easy to lay - no specific direction.

Like all flooring from Tarkett Sommer Monolit also has a great advantage when it comes to installation. The seams are heat welded with matching thread which provides a watertight and hygienic installation. The flooring can be easily moulded and coved up walls and round corners.

Furthermore, Monolit can be laid in any direction, which makes laying even easier.

Tarkett supply technical support, printed installation and cleaning instructions and instruction videos to ensure a good end result.







The result is a total of 24 colourways, of which there are 6 colour families in 3 different hues (light, medium, dark). There are also


2 cool and 3 warm greys, plus 1 black to complete the picture.
